



DOG PARK BASIC RULES Be A Responsible Dog Owner



Immunized Dogs Only: Don't bring your unvaccinated dog or puppy to the dog park. Rapid spread of disease can occur, some fatal. Most parks will prohibit the entry of puppies until they're four months old, the common age when puppy shots are finished.

Bring a Healthy Dog: It's common sense to keep an unhealthy dog home. If your dog is suffering from Kennel Cough, Fleas, Mange, or other health issues, the dog park is not the place to go!

Clean Up After Your Dog: Leaving dog piles can cause disease and intestinal parasites, besides being very rude to others visiting the park.

Human Children At Off-Leash Dog Parks: There are many good reasons to keep children out of off-leash dog parks, and no good reasons to bring them in. The possibilities for accidents are staggering. Be a responsible parent, and keep your small children in the parks designed for them.

Female Dogs In Heat: NO!

Don't Bring Too Many Dogs: Make sure you can handle and control the number of dogs you bring. Do not exceed the limit. Always closely supervise your dog(s).

Never Bring Other Non-Dog Animals

Be Responsible For Your Dog's Behavior: Exercise your dog before bringing him in to the park where he will socialize. him in to the park when he's calm and NOT overly excited. If your dog digs a hole, fill it. If he can not play nicely with other dogs on that day, then take him home. If he's not having fun, take him home.

Entering The Dog Park: It will be easier for your dog to adjust if you take his leash off in the center area before entering either side.
